

# ATTENTION

## OLYMPIA RESIDENTS

Welcome to OLYMPIA!! We want you to have a safe and enjoyable time at the OLYMPIA pool and CLUBHOUSE. With 'SEASON' right around the corner, we want to remind you of the policies for using the amenities.

PLEASE do your part - make sure you, your guests and children are aware of and follow the policies adopted by the Master Board of Directors. If you see a resident breaking the rules or abusing the policies, please contact the clubhouse immediately.

### Access and Use

- **RESIDENTS MUST** show their access card to desk attendant prior to using the facilities.
- **ACCESS ID CARDS** are for residents only and are not transferable.
- **CHILDREN** under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older in the Clubhouse, Basketball Court & at the Pool.
- **EACH HOUSEHOLD** is allowed six (6) guests at the Pool.
- **RESIDENTS** must accompany their guests at all times; if the resident is not present, the guest will be asked to leave.
- **FOOD**, beverages, glass, chewing gum and metal objects are not allowed in the Clubhouse or pool area.
- **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** are not allowed in the pool area or on the Clubhouse grounds.
- **DIAPER STAGE** persons must wear a swim diaper in the pool.
- **NO SMOKING** inside the pool gate or in the Clubhouse.
- **DRESS CODE** enforced. Appropriate bathing attire required and Cover up must be worn in the clubhouse. Shoes must be worn in all areas of the Clubhouse and grounds.
- **FITNESS CENTER** is for residents only over the age of 16. Guests are NOT allowed.
- **RESIDENTS** over the age of 18 are allowed to bring two (2) guests in the Basketball Court.

5 p.m. beginning November 9, 2011

(Daylight Savings Time Ends)

## Conduct

Abuse of the common area amenities may constitute grounds for immediate restriction of use of facilities. No owner shall make himself or permit his family, agents, visitors, tenants or invitees to make any disruptive or disturbing noises as to annoy others. If management needs to contact security or the police due to aggressive or offensive behavior, the resident or guest will be escorted from the property and will not be allowed to use any Master Association Common Property, pending the decision of the Violation Committee at a duly noted Committee hearing. Owners and tenants are liable for the cost of repair resulting from damage caused indirectly or directly by themselves and/or their guests to any common area amenity. Collection of costs of repair will be the same as a past due assessment. The Board of Directors has the right to suspend the use privileges of any owner, tenant or guest for any violation of the Rules and Regulations as deemed necessary.
